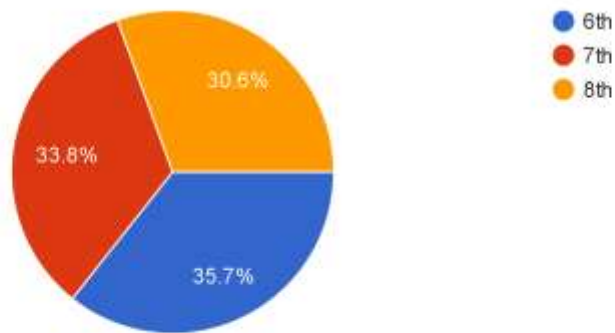
Hinckley-Big Rock Middle School Survey Results

The purpose of this survey was to gather information from our students at Hinckley-Big Rock Middle School (HBRMS) on the use and distribution of Chromebooks. The student responses will be used to help determine our plans for the use and distribution of Chromebooks during the 2019-2020 school year at HBRMS.

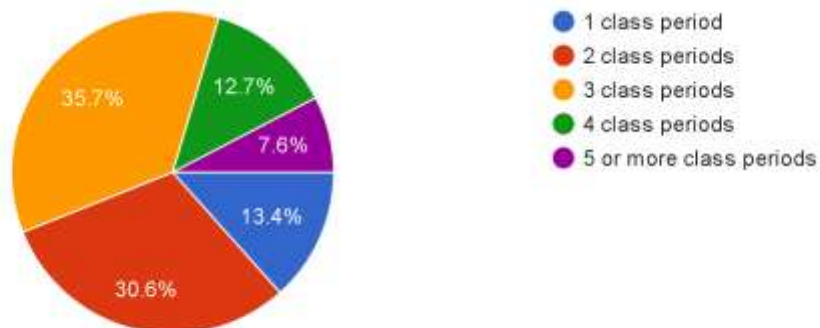
What is your grade level?

157 responses



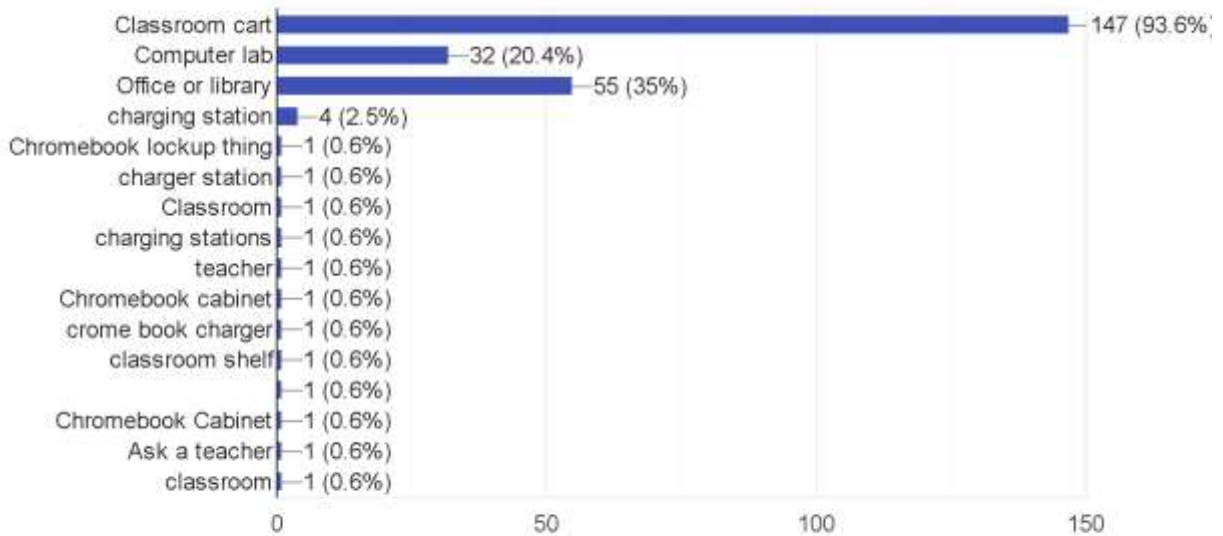
Estimate the number of periods that you use a Chromebook in an average day at HBRMS:

Additional Information:: 40.1% of students responded that they would like to be assigned a specific chromebook that they could take home, 40.1% would like carts of Chromebooks in classrooms, and 14% of students would like to be assigned a specific chromebook that would be distributed and collected daily.

- What are the problems you face when using technology during class time?
- Why would you prefer this type of Chromebook distribution?
- What would be helpful about this type of Chromebook distribution?
