



## Hinckley-Big Rock CUSD #429 Non-Chromebook Lab Plans

The following computer labs at HBR do not currently utilize Chromebooks. The plans for continued use of these labs moving forward are described below.

### **HBRMS Library Lab**

*Current situation* - This lab is stocked with 20 student computers and monitors. The use of this lab has diminished over the years, and even more so this year with the increased Chromebook availability in the building.

*Future plans* - There is not a need to continue this lab with PC computers and monitors. The Chromebook computers meet the learning needs of our students when considering technology infused learning. The computers may be replaced with Chromebooks. This will be finalized after the building level plan for daily use of Chromebooks is determined. The use of this space will continue to be assessed to ensure we have the appropriate technology tools available for our students.

### **HBRHS 607 Lab**

*Current situation* - This lab is stocked with 24 student computers and monitors. The use of this PC lab is primarily for programs that are not available on a Chromebook. The lab is currently utilized regularly for Introduction to Programming, Digital Communication Technology, Web Design 1 and 2, and Photography. The lab can be reserved for other courses during the class periods when it is not in use for one of the courses listed. This computer lab is also utilized periodically for staff trainings and for FAFSA completion workshops for parents.

*Future plans* - There is a need to continue this lab with PC computers in order to meet the learning needs of our students when considering technology infused learning. At this time, some programs that are integral to the course offerings listed above do not lend themselves to a web-based platform. This will continue to be assessed to determine our ongoing plan to ensure we have the appropriate technology tools available for our students.
